Panorama Mountain Facts



Panorama has 2,975 acres of terrain – ranging from wide open fall-line cruisers to powder-filled tree lines and the steep and deep exhilaration of Taynton Bowl.

Panorama is ranked as #1 resort for most space per skier among the world's 100 largest ski areas according to a 2019 [report](#) by European researcher Montenius Consulting. What does this mean? Think vast areas of skiable terrain, wide open groomed runs and a selection of chairlifts that efficiently spreads people out across the mountain.

The ski area is perfect for a variety of abilities with 50% of the runs suitable for beginners or intermediates. Think beautiful wide corduroy, winding down the fall-line right to the village or the door of your condo.

For black-diamond runs, head to Taynton Bowl. Formerly a heli-skiing area, Taynton Bowl is now within bounds, so the slopes are patrolled, avalanche controlled and no backcountry gear is needed. Warm up first as the 750 acre bowl is all black runs. It's a great place to find hidden powder stashes days after a storm.

PANORAMA SPRINGS POOLS



The Panorama Springs Pools include a warm pool, two hot tubs and one large cold pool with a wading area. Towels are supplied and showers and lockers are available at no extra charge, just be sure to bring your own lock.

- **Lower Hot Tub - 98F, 218 sq ft**

All Panorama lodging guests have access to the pools, slides and hot tubs with their room key card. Children will enjoy splashing around and swimming in the pools and waterslides which include a wading area and splash pad while adults can relax in the hot tubs, letting the jets gently massage their worries away. Don't forget to try out the sauna, also located in the pool area.

Summit lodge

Centrally located, Summit Lodge is one of Panorama's premium lodging options. These ski-in / ski-out units are adjacent to the Springs Pools and groomed trails, they're also just a short walk from Fireside Cafe for morning coffee. Summit Lodge is one of the higher end options in Panorama in a great location.
